What is the My Career Insights Project and Morrisby Profiling?

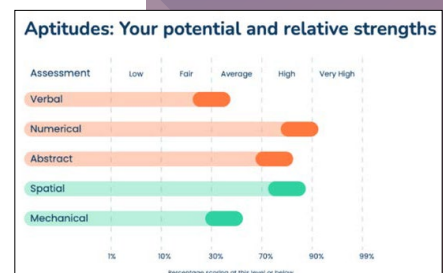
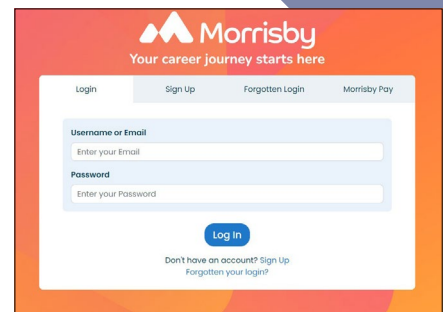
My Career Insights is a program for all Year 9 students (or equivalent in specialist settings) in Victorian Government Secondary Schools. Your child has been given the opportunity to complete their own Morrisby profile and participate in a 30-minute interview with a Morrisby trained Careers Consultant. It is a unique opportunity for them to learn more about their strengths and abilities while exploring potential career options, giving them the confidence to start taking control of their future.

Morrisby is an interactive, online profiling tool used to support one's career journey based on their aptitudes, interests, personality and career goals. Your child has lifelong access and as they change, it can change with them.

How you can support your child to use their Morrisby Profile in Year 10

- Encourage them to login to their profile at app.morrisby.com and revise their information and choices so that as their interests change, their profile changes with them. Your child has access to an instructional guide on logging in to their profile which includes information on how to reset their password if they have forgotten it.
- Read through your child's profile with them and encourage them to complete any steps they may have missed or are suggested for them to retake. They can also retake questionnaires if they feel that the profile does not provide an accurate reflection of who they are now.
- Ask your child about the careers in their favourites list and explore the information, videos, and resources together. Are they still interested in these careers?
- Ask your child about their profile and have a conversation about their suitability to their chosen careers. Remember to focus on their strengths, this is the most important part!

- Have a conversation about the employment opportunities within your area. Do you have any networks or contacts your child could talk to or perhaps complete work experience with?
- Explore the different senior secondary options and subjects available in Years 11 and 12. You can help your child understand and decide what would be the best fit for them.
- Remember, your child's Morrisby Profile is just one tool that can be used to help them make informed decisions on their career journey.



Please note: If you find that your child does not have access to the aptitudes assessment, this could be because a response was not received with your consent to participate in year 9. The full profile is useful for gaining a more detailed understanding of your child's strengths and capabilities. Full profiling, including aptitudes questionnaires will become available to your child once they turn 18, or when parental permission is granted to the school. Please speak with your school's career staff if you would like access to the aptitudes questionnaires arranged for your child.
