#### Peesi Fakaikiiki he Morrisby

'E kole 'e he 'apiako ki ho'o ki'i leká ke ne fakakakato ha 'ū tesi. 'E ngāue 'aki 'e he Morrisby 'a 'enau talí ke fa'u ha peesi fakaikiiki makehe ke hā atu ai e:

- to'oto'o konga lalahi 'a 'enau ngaahi mālohunga fakatāutahá pea mo 'enau ngaahi manakó
- fale'i ange 'a e ngaahi halanga ngāue fakapa'anga pea mo e ngaahi fili fakaako kehekehe.
