## TOPIC

## Unpacking the Morrisby Profile Part 1 *Reviewing your Profile*

### LESSON 3

**Teacher notes:** My Career Insights is offered in two parts:

- **Part 1:** An online profiling session which includes a series of assessments and questionnaires, accessed via the Morrisby website.
- **Part 2:** One-on-one student interviews conducted by independent Careers Consultants to “unpack” the Morrisby Profile and demonstrate system functionality for ongoing use.

Prior to this lesson, students should have completed their online Morrisby Profile and participated in a one-on-one interview.

In this lesson, students build on what they learnt during their interview and consider their strengths, talents and interests in relation to associated career fields, subject options and pathway suggestions. Students are asked to become familiar with their personal Profile for further career development conversations at school.

### Key Messages

- Vocational assessment is one way of discovering your interests, strengths and talents.

### Learning Outcome

By the end of the lesson students will have:

- Explored their Morrisby results
- Summarised key findings
- Reflected on their perception/reaction to their Profile

### Purpose

To assist students to understand their individual Profile.

### Suggested Activities

For this lesson you will need:

- PowerPoint presentation – *Understanding your Morrisby Results*
  - A copy of the student e-workbook – *Unpacking Your Morrisby Profile* for each student
  - Access to Morrisby Online via pc, laptop or tablet.
1. Present the *Understanding Your Morrisby Results* PowerPoint presentation to re-familiarise students with key features of their Profile.
  2. Students then log in to their Morrisby online account and complete activities detailed in Part 1 of the student e-workbook, *Unpacking Your Morrisby Profile*.
  3. If time permits, students can commence their career exploration using the “Planner” tab in their online Profile.

## Unpacking the Morrisby Profile Part 2 *Investigating Career Suggestions*

### LESSON 4

**Teacher notes:** My Career Insights is offered in two parts:

Prior to this lesson, students should have completed their online Morrisby Profile and participated in a one-on-one interview. They should also have completed activities from Part 1 of the student e-workbook, *Unpacking Your Morrisby Profile*.

### Key Messages

- Your career starts at school. As a student, you build your knowledge, skills and aptitudes
- Career exploration and investigation are important parts of pathway planning.

### Learning Outcome

By the end of the lesson students will have:

- Investigated careers suggested in their Morrisby Profile
- Reflected on their perception/reaction to the career suggestions.

### Purpose

To investigate the range of career suggestions included in the Morrisby Profile. To investigate career fields and specific occupations. To use the links within the Profile and/or other websites/resources and to develop any questions or highlight areas of interest that they may wish to follow up/investigate further.

### Suggested Activities

For this lesson you will need:

- A copy of the student e-workbook – *Unpacking Your Morrisby Profile* for each student
  - Access to Morrisby Online via pc, laptop or tablet.
1. Students log in to their Morrisby online account and complete activities in Part 2 of the student e-workbook, *Unpacking Your Morrisby Profile*.
  2. Students complete three career investigations, recording answers against questions detailed in Part 2 of their e-workbook.
