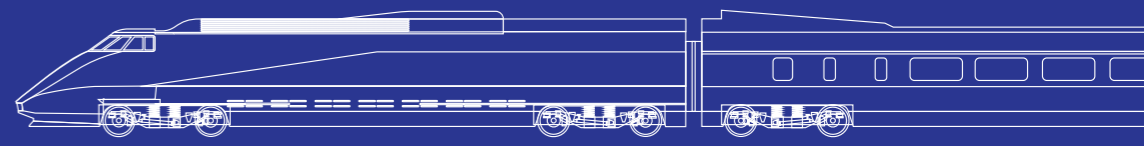

Signal Operator:

Railway Signal Operators control the movement of trains and assemble and disassemble trains within a marshalling yard.

Railway Track Plant Operator:

Railway Track Plant Operators drive plant to align and carry out maintenance work on railway tracks as well as maintaining the equipment. It is a position that requires a lot of outdoor and practical hands-on work.



Ganger:

It is the responsibility of the supervisor, ganger or team leader to assess hazards, determine risk, conduct regular inspections, and maintain a safe site for their workers, while scheduling and completing track works on time.

Environment & Sustainability Officer:

This position coordinates the various environmental activities of an organisation including adherence to environmental policies and standards as well as internal and external programmes aimed at improving environmental sustainability credentials.



Project Manager:

Project managers begin each project by defining the main objectives, purpose and scope. They identify key internal and external stakeholders, discuss expectations, and gain the required authorization to move a project forward. Project planning doesn't end until the project does.

Work Health & Safety, and Compliance:

The OHS Officer is responsible for providing advice on workplace health and safety injury management.
