Name of Lesson:

Post school options - Next Steps.

Learning Intentions:

Students will be able to build student knowledge and understanding of career pathways and the related post-school options, in order to make informed choices about what steps they need to take to reach their post-school destination.

Success Criteria:

I can identify the level of education and training that is required for my career choices (for example, Degree, Vocational (Certificate I-IV), etc.).

I understand the qualification level I will need to obtain to enter further education, training and/or employment (for example, VCE, VCE VM, etc.).

I can use the Morrisby Profile tool and related resources to source this information and record next steps.

Prior Knowledge/ Concepts/ Skills:

Students have completed the My Career Insights program in Year 9 including online profiling and a one-on-one interview with a Careers Consultant.

Lesson Description

ACTIVITY 1 – Post School Options

PART 1 – Exploring post school options 40-50 minutes

Access the student e-workbook - Post school options - Next Steps

Different occupations have different entry requirements. It is important to understand what level of education or training you need to work in the field you are interested in. For example, some careers require a tertiary qualification while others require an apprenticeship or traineeship. It is equally important to understand the senior secondary achievements you will need to enter the post-school option you aspire to.

- 1. Log in to your Morrisby Profile.
- 2. Go to your Planner and review the subjects listed in your options at 16/17 (current subjects) so that they accurately reflect what you are doing.
- 3. Review your hearted careers, setting the qualification level to match your aspirations.
- 4. Use the Post School Options tab in your Morrisby Profile to explore, research and determine any requirements or other useful information for your chosen career options and add them to your planner.
- 5. Use the Next Steps tool in your Morrisby Profile to create a plan of the next steps in your journey. This could include making appointments to speak with experts, completing applications etc.
