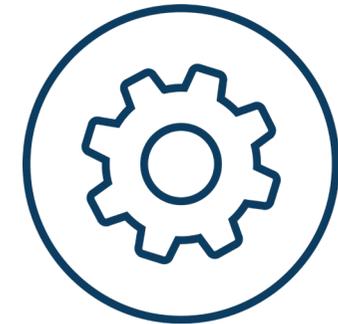

as an option to turn on.

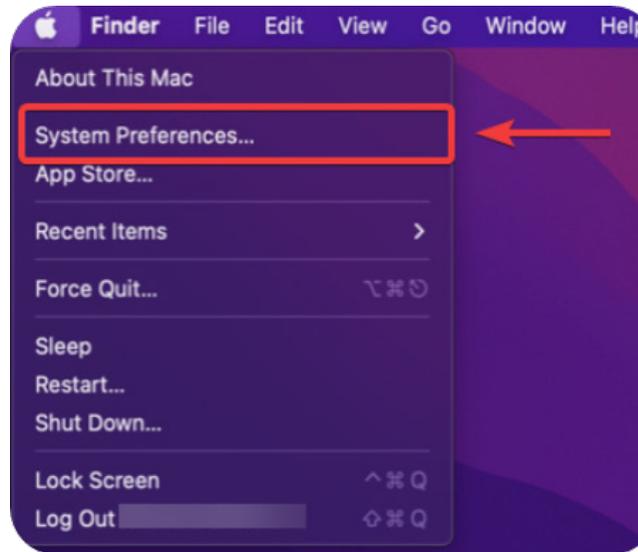


Caused by

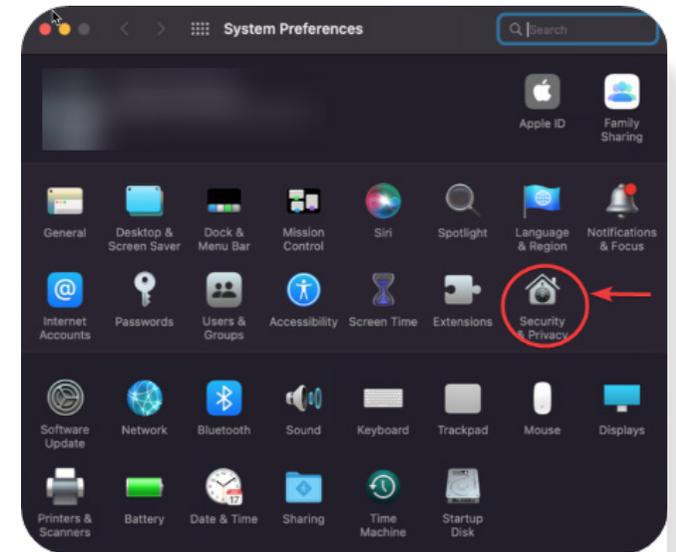
## TO ALLOW CAMERA AND MICROPHONE ACCESS



### STEP 1

You can easily turn it back on by going to the Apple in the upper left corner and select **System Preferences**, then select **Security and Privacy**.

If you don't see them, click on the **four by 3 (12 dots panel)** to get to the various options under System Preferences.



### STEP 2

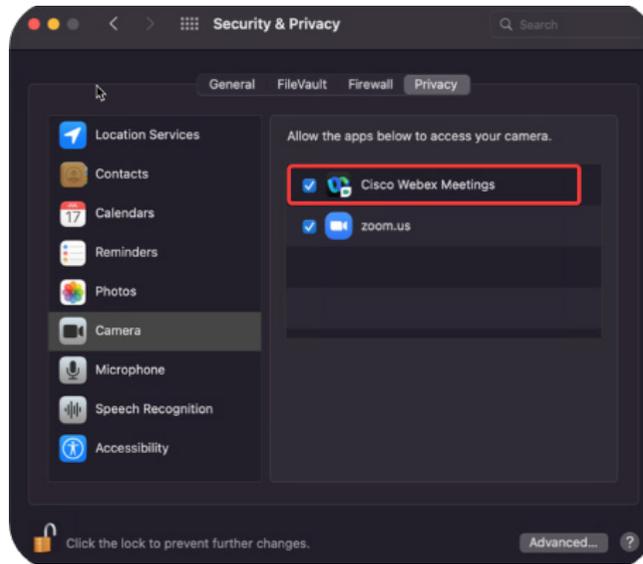
Under **Security and Privacy**, you may see several items referring to WebEx Meetings or other tools of WebEx, like WebEx Events.

Make sure there is a **check mark in the box next to these items**. If there is already a check mark and your camera is still not seen by WebEx Meetings. Remove the checkmark and click in the box to put it back in.



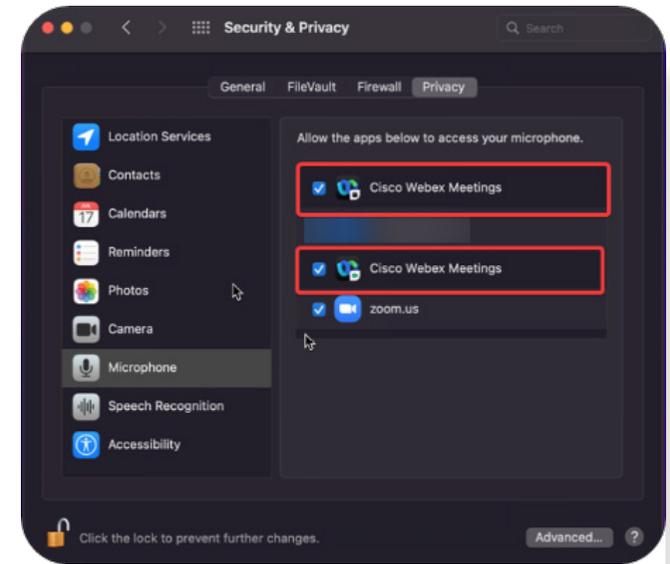
### STEP 3

You might need to unlock these settings by clicking on the **Lock on the bottom left** and inputting your **username and password**.



### STEP 4

Check for under **Camera Settings**.



### STEP 5

While you are there you can also check your **Microphone Settings**.

Additional WebEx Centers allow them to use your camera.
