1) Employment in Australia in the future

- Positive job growth in Australia is expected to continue across most industries.
- There will be almost 950,000 more jobs in Australia by 2030.

3) Why jobs will increase in these Industries

- Health Care & Social Assistance - Driven by an ageing population, expanded NDIS services, and growing mental health support needs.
- Education & Training - Population growth, teacher shortages, and increased demand for adult and vocational learning.
- Construction & Infrastructure - Housing demand and government-funded projects (roads, rail, energy).
- Technology & Digital Services - Growing use of Artificial Intelligence (AI), cybersecurity needs, app development, and digital transformation in every industry.
- Clean Energy & Sustainability - Shift toward renewables and environmental sustainability jobs (solar, wind, battery storage).

4) Young people and jobs in the future

- Many young people are already working in sectors that are growing.
- Entry-level opportunities will continue in retail, hospitality, care roles, trades, and digital services.
- Young people with soft skills (communication, teamwork, problem-solving) and tech skills will be especially in demand.

5) Technology and the future

- Technology is transforming every workplace. Workplaces will use more AI, automation & robotics, 3D printing & smart devices, augmented and virtual reality (AR/VR).
- Emerging technology jobs include app developers, drone pilots, AI trainers, VR designers, social media specialists, cybersecurity analysts.
