What is the EMCI Program?

The Enhanced My Career Insights
Program (EMCI) is a pilot program
funded by the Victorian Department of
Education and facilitated by the
Australian Centre for Career Education
(ACCE). The program connects selected
Year 9 and 10 students with an EMCI
Career Consultant who will offer
additional supports for students to build
confidence to engage with the world of
careers and work. This engagement is
integrated as part of the My Career
Insights Program.





How does the EMCI Program work?

Over 4 or more sessions students will work with a Career Consultant to:

- Review their Morrisby profile
- Identify individual interests and career goals
- Build work readiness skills
- Assist with resume development
- Prepare for the world of work
- Participate in mock job interviews
- Update their Career Action Plan

How does a student participate in the EMCI Program?

Your school will nominate selected students to participate in the EMCI program.

Parent/Guardian Consent

Parent/Guardian consent is required for a young person to participate. Please complete the consent form and return it to your school as soon as possible. Verbal consent can also be provided over the phone to a relevant school staff member. Once consent has been gained your school will refer students to ACCE for an individual meeting.



THE PROGRAM

STEP 1 - Your Consent



Your school might ask you for written or verbal consent

YOUR ROLE

Follow your school's instructions to provide consent.

STEP 2 - EMCI Program Career Consultant Meeting



The school will arrange an individual meeting between the EMCI Career Consultant and your child. They will talk about Morrisby and provide additional support to assist with career exploration and work readiness skills Look out for communication from your school about the EMCI Program and Career Consultant interview

STEP 3 - Career Planning



The Career Consultant can help your child update their career action plan by discussing career goals and work-based learning activities which includes industry tasters, workplace tours, career expos, work experience opportunities, mentoring, guest speakers, workshops, facilitating mock job interview

Talk with your child about their profile, interests, strengths, goals and study options
